

Apart from NPK, Indian soils are suffering from micro nutrient deficiency, secondary and micro nutrients also. Deficiency of a nutrient in soil has its reflection on human nutrition which must be addressed through formation and creation of congenial policy environment. I. The participation fee

The programme fee per Participant is as below:
