

CONNECTIVITY

Ramnagar is the best approach to the Jim Corbett National Park. Ramnagar is very well connected by Rail and Road.

By Road: Ramnagar is well connected **via road** with New Delhi, Lucknow, Kanpur and Dehradun. Distance between Delhi and Jim Corbett National Park by road is 288 km. Ramnagar's Tanda Bazar Bus Stop is 24 kms from the Hotel. Regular buses ply between important cities like Delhi-Ramnagar and Lucknow-Ramnagar.
